**Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- SB 1527  
Decreases penalty for crime of cheating to maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.
- SB 1528  
Requires Oregon Liquor Control Commission inspector or investigator enforcing laws related to liquor to obtain Department of Public Safety Standards and Training certification as liquor enforcement inspector.

**Public Hearing**

- SB 1534  
Creates crime of aggravated solicitation applicable to use of electronic communication to solicit two or more persons to commit specific crime at specific time and location.
- SB 1557  
Makes consumption of controlled substance by person under 21 years of age unlawful.
