CARRIED OVER FROM 2/3/2012 AGENDA - FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Exempts certain accident only, specified disease and hospital indemnity insurance policies from payment of assessment on gross amount of premiums.

HB 4127 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means CARRIED OVER FROM 2/3/2012 AGENDA - FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Oregon Health Authority adopt standards and procedures to certify specified mental health providers to qualify for insurance reimbursement.

HB 4074 **
