HB 4009

CARRIERD OVER FROM 2/1/2012 AGENDA: Eliminates monitoring entity from impaired health professional program.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4011

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/1/2012 AGENDA: Requires person convicted of driving while under influence of intoxicants to submit proof that person completed required treatment program before reinstatement of driving privileges.

HB 4164

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/1/2012 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation to establish and deposit moneys into accounts in federally insured depositories.

HB 4010

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires insurers to reimburse nurse practitioners at same rate as physicians for same services.

HB 4046
