Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 4022 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Expands definition of "mentally ill person" for purposes of civil commitment proceedings to include persons with substance dependence associated with opioids and two prior convictions for unlawful possession of heroin and for whom compelled treatment is necessary to avoid reoffending.
- HB 4021 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Superintendent of State Police to commission employees of humane investigation agency as humane special agents under certain circumstances.
- HB 4095 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/6/2012 AGENDA - Allows Jackson, Josephine and Douglas Counties to enter into intergovernmental agreement.
- HB 4045
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/6/2012 AGENDA - Authorizes person applying for concealed handgun license to limit ability of public body to disclose records or information that identifies person as applicant for, or holder of, concealed handgun license.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/6/2012 AGENDA - Creates community guardianships as permanency planning option for ward in substitute care.
- HB 4025 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/6/2012 AGENDA - Reduces amount payable by municipal or justice court for deposit in Criminal Fine Account from \$60 to \$45.
