Re: SB 1512 – Mercury in Fluorescent Lights - Support

The League of Women Voters is a nonpartisan, grassroots political organization that encourages informed and active participation in government. We support SB 1512, because we believe it is an important step forward in lessening the serious health risks associated with the presence of mercury in fluorescent lights.

Although fluorescent lights are an excellent energy-saving tool, the mercury contained within them has been shown to damage the brain, liver, and kidneys and can cause developmental disorders in children. In our opinion, SB 1512 provides an effective three-prong approach that will help to alleviate the harmful effects of mercury on our health and on the environment. It will reduce the mercury content of bulbs sold in Oregon, improve the collection and recycling process of these bulbs, and provide consumer education to optimize recycling.

The League bases its support for SB 1512 on our belief that early intervention and prevention measures are key to ensuring children's health. Also, our solid waste position asserts that government has an important role to play in setting standards to ensure maximum protection of public health and the environment.

The League strongly urges passage of SB 1512, and we appreciate the opportunity to present our views.
