2 “(3) By November 1, 2013, the process described in subsection (1) of
3 this section must be made available to all school districts for imple-

5 “SECTION 15. (1) By February 4, 2013, the Early Learning Council
6 established by section 4, chapter 519, Oregon Laws 2011, shall submit
7 a report to the Legislative Assembly on the functions and adminis-
8 tration of community-based coordinators of early learning services,
9 including but not limited to:

10 “(a) The contracting criteria and process for implementing the
11 community-based coordination structure.

12 “(b) The relationship between community-based coordinators of
13 early learning services and a comprehensive children’s budget, as de-
14 scribed in section 12 of this 2012 Act.

29 lished by section 4, chapter 519, Oregon Laws 2011, shall work with the
30 Department of Education and other state agencies and shall:

1 “(b) Services are provided in a cost-efficient manner; and

2 “(c) The services provided, and the means by which those services
3 are provided, are focused on the outcomes of the services.

4 “(4) An entity may become a community-based coordinator of early
5 learning services by submitting to the council an application that
6 demonstrates the following:

7 “(a) The entity is able to coordinate the provision of early learning
8 services to the community that will be served by the entity. An entity
9 may make the demonstration required by this paragraph by submit-
10 ting evidence that local stakeholders, including but not limited to
11 service providers, parents, community members, county governments,
12 local governments and school districts, have participated in the de-
13 velopment of the application.

14 “(b) The services coordinated by the entity will be in alignment with
15 the services provided by the public schools of the community that will
16 be served by the entity.

17 “(c) The entity will make advantageous use of the system of public
18 health care and services available through county health departments
19 and other publicly supported programs delivered through, or in part-
20 nership with, counties.

21 “(d) The entity has a governing body or an advisory body that:

22 “(A) Has the authority to initiate audits, recommend the terms of
23 a contract and provide reports to the public and to the Early Learning
24 Council on the outcomes of the provision of early learning services to
25 the community served by the entity.

27 “(e) The entity will collaborate on documentation related to coord-
28 inated services with public and private entities that are identified by
29 the Early Learning Council as providers of services that advance the
30 early learning of children.
