**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1525**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2012 Act is added to and made a part**
4 **of ORS 181.610 to 181.712.**

5 **“SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an**
6 **individual who is employed full time by a tribal government to perform**
7 **the duties of a public safety officer and who possesses the requisite**
8 **qualifications may be certified or recertified as a police officer, certi-**
9 **fied reserve officer, corrections officer, parole and probation officer,**
10 **fire service professional, telecommunicator or emergency medical dis-**
11 **patcher if the individual and the tribal government comply with the**
12 **applicable provisions of ORS 181.610 to 181.712.**

13 **“(2) An individual who is certified under subsection (1) of this sec-**
14 **tion is considered to be employed as a full-time public safety officer**
15 **in the discipline in which the certification is held for the following**
16 **purposes:**

17 **“(a) Denying, suspending or revoking certification under ORS**
18 **181.661, 181.662 and 181.664;**

19 **“(b) Determining eligibility to apply for benefits from the Public**
20 **Safety Memorial Fund under ORS 243.954 to 243.974; and**

21 **“(c) Determining eligibility to be honored at the memorial created**
22 **pursuant to section 1, chapter 508, Oregon Laws 1987.**

1 **SECTION 3. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate**
2 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
3 **declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
