  Act.
- Membership of the board shall be in accordance with the requirements of section 2821(b) of the federal Act.
- Representatives of business described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act who are appointed to the board shall be subject to Senate confirmation.
- Governor selects the chairperson according to 2821(c) of the federal Act.
- A majority of the board shall re representatives of business, as described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act.
- Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the board are nonvoting members of the boards and may act in an advisory capacity only.
- To transact business at a meeting of the board, a quorum of voting members must participate. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the voting members. At least 25 percent of the members participating shall be representative of business, as described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act.

- Two members of the Senate appointed by the Senate President (GEORGE, ROSENBAUM, BEYER, HUFFMAN)
- Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker (BEYER, HUFFMAN)
  - o Business representative positions (**BROWN**, DICKENSON, GLASS, LEWIS, LUCHAK, NEEF, PARK, PRYOR, RE'VOAL, WILKINSON, WILLIAMS)
  - Chief elected officials (a county commissioner, county judge or the mayor of the City of Portland) (UNGER)
  - Labor organization representatives, nominated by a state labor federation (BAKER, DORGAN, KING)
  - Representatives of individuals or organizations that have experience with youth activities (HELZERMAN)
  - Representatives of individuals or organizations with experience and expertise in delivery of workforce investment activities, including chief executive officers of community colleges or community-based organizations (ROBERTS)
