Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Health Authority to develop and maintain lead poisoning prevention clearinghouse on its website.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:

HB 4015 requires the Oregon Health Authority to develop and maintain a lead poisoning prevention clearinghouse on its website that would serve as a resource for public and private schools that provide instruction to students from grades kindergarten through twelfth.

Passage of this bill will have no impact on the Oregon Health Authority. The authority reports that the all of the information that the bill requires is currently available on the following website:
