Measure Description:

Establishes Board of Commercial Interior Design, imposes civil penalty for violation of provisions relating to the regulation of commercial interior design, establishes the Board of Commercial Interior Design Fund and continuously appropriates monies in fund to the board, authorized the board to hire and set the compensation for an executive director, creates rule making authority.
