Impact Explanation:

The Legislative Assembly created the *Connect*-Oregon program in 2005 to provide funding in the form of grants and loans for non-highway transportation projects, including aviation, marine, passenger and freight rail and public transportation projects. The initial program provided \$100 million in lottery-backed bonds. it was followed by an additional \$100 million in 2007 and 2009. The Legislative Assembly approved \$40 million for *Connect*-Oregon IV in 2011. House Bill 4028 authorizes an additional \$10 million in lottery bonds to be awarded to qualified applicants for *Connect*-Oregon IV projects
