WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Officer Chris Kilcullen of the Eugene Police Department.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Chris Kilcullen was born and raised in Eugene. He graduated from Willamette High School, then the University of Oregon, and in 1998 he joined the Eugene Police Department. In his twelve-year career he earned more than 85 commendations; was twice named the Department's Employee of the Month; was crucial to creating the Department's Crisis Intervention Team; and served on the Department's Crisis Negotiation Team.

Officer Kilcullen was killed in the line of duty on April 22, 2011. He is survived by his wife, Kristie, his daughter, Katie Ann, and his stepdaughter, Sidney. Last year a part of State Highway 126 was renamed the "Officer Kilcullen Memorial Highway" in his memory, running from the intersection of Highway 26 and West 7th Avenue in Eugene to its intersection with Main Street in Springfield. Senate Concurrent Resolution 201 recognizes his service to the people of the state of Oregon.
