1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “ORS 285B.551 and”.

2 After line 4, insert:

3 “**SECTION 1. Sections 3 and 4 of this 2012 Act and the amendments to section 20, chapter**
4 **624, Oregon Laws 2011, by section 2 of this 2012 Act shall be known and may be cited as the**
5 **Transportation and Economic Development Act of 2012.**”.

6 In line 5, delete “1” and insert “2”.

7 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 45 and delete page 3.

8 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 7.

9 Delete lines 37 through 42 and insert:

10 “(2) Net proceeds of lottery bonds issued pursuant to this section must be deposited in the
11 Community College Capital Construction Fund established under ORS 341.725 sufficient to provide
12 \$9,604,450 in net proceeds and interest earnings for the Department of Community Colleges and
13 Workforce Development to finance the following projects with a targeted workforce preparation and
14 development focus that have been prioritized by all 17 community colleges in this state in the fol-
15 lowing amounts:

44 “(5) Following the sale of bonds for projects described in subsection (2) of this section, the De-
45 partment of Community Colleges and Workforce Development shall submit a progress report to the

1 Legislative Assembly. The progress report shall include all of the following information for each
2 project described in subsection (2) of this section:

3 “(a) The planned start date of the project.

4 “(b) The actual start date of the project.

5 “(c) The current status of the project.

6 “(d) The project completion date or scheduled completion date.

7 “(e) Expenditures made for the project to date.

8 “(f) The number of construction hours worked.

9 “(g) The proportion of funds used for equipment purchase and new construction.

10 “(h) The percentage of jobs performed or contracts fulfilled by Oregon residents.

11 “(i) A description of increased program capacity resulting from the project.

12 “(j) A description of the local workforce need addressed by the project.”.

13 Delete lines 10 through 33.

14 In line 34, delete “6” and insert “5”.

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
