SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Authorizes person applying for concealed handgun license to limit ability of public body to disclose] **Prohibits public body from disclosing** records or information that identifies person as applicant for, or holder of, concealed handgun license. **Makes exceptions.**

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the public disclosure of concealed handgun license information; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) A public body may not disclose records or information that identifies a**
6 **person as a current or former applicant for, or holder of, a concealed handgun license, un-**
7 **less:**

8 (a) **The disclosure is made to another public body and is necessary for criminal justice**
9 **purposes;**

10 (b) **A court enters an order in a criminal or civil case directing the public body to disclose**
11 **the records or information; or**

12 (c) **The holder of, or applicant for, the concealed handgun license consents to the disclo-**
13 **sure in writing.**

14 (2) **As used in this section, "public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 192.410,**
15 **except that "public body" does not include the Judicial Department.**

16 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2012 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2013.**

17 (2) **The Department of State Police and any other public body may adopt rules or take**
18 **any other action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is**
19 **necessary to enable the department or public body to comply, on and after the operative date**
20 **specified in subsection (1) of this section, with the provisions of section 1 of this 2012 Act.**

21 **SECTION 3. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
22 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect**
23 **on its passage.**
