

House Bill 4054

Sponsored by Representative THOMPSON; Representatives PARRISH, WEIDNER (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits Public Employees' Benefit Board from authorizing or requiring collection of information or maintenance of records about firearms from eligible employee or family member.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to collection of information about firearms by state agencies; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2012 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.105 to**
5 **243.285.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The Public Employees' Benefit Board, or an employee or agent of the**
7 **board, may not require or authorize the collection or disclosure from an eligible employee**
8 **or family member of any information related to:**

9 (a) **The presence or storage of a lawfully possessed firearm or ammunition in the resi-**
10 **dence or on the property of the employee or family member; or**

11 (b) **The lawful use, possession or storage of a firearm or ammunition by the employee**
12 **or family member.**

13 (2) **Nothing in ORS 243.061 or 243.105 to 243.285 may be construed to authorize the col-**
14 **lection of any information or the maintenance of records about:**

15 (a) **The lawful ownership or possession of a firearm or ammunition;**

16 (b) **The lawful use of a firearm or ammunition; or**

17 (c) **The lawful storage of a firearm or ammunition.**

18 (3) **An eligible employee or family member may not be required to disclose any informa-**
19 **tion under any data collection activity authorized under ORS 243.061 or 243.105 to 243.285**
20 **related to:**

21 (a) **The lawful ownership or possession of a firearm or ammunition;**

22 (b) **The lawful use of a firearm or ammunition; or**

23 (c) **The lawful storage of a firearm or ammunition.**

24 **SECTION 3. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
25 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect**
26 **on its passage.**
