

# House Bill 4171

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies deadline for Secretary of State to file information with county clerks regarding candidates for offices of President and Vice President of United States at November 2012 general election.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to election filing deadlines; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 254.085, for purposes of the general election to be held**  
5 **in November 2012, the Secretary of State, not later than the 60th day before the date of the**  
6 **general election, shall file with each county clerk a statement containing information re-**  
7 **garding candidates for the offices of President and Vice President of the United States.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2012 Act is repealed on January 2, 2013.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
