SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Permits certain counties to use federal forest reserve moneys in county road funds for law enforcement purposes related to roads. Permits counties to loan federal forest reserve moneys from road fund to fund used for law enforcement purposes related to roads.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to county road funds; creating new provisions; amending section 4, chapter 894, Oregon
3 Laws 2007; repealing section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section 1, chapter 556,
6 Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 4.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) that
8 are received by [*Douglas County*] **a county listed in subsection (2) of this section** and deposited
9 into [*its*] **that county's** road fund may be expended for the patrolling of [*Douglas County*] **that**
10 **county's** roads by [*Douglas County*] **that county's** law enforcement officials.

11 (2) [*Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) that are re-*
12 *ceived by Lane County and deposited into its road fund may be expended for the patrolling of Lane*
13 *County roads by Lane County law enforcement officials.*] **Subsection (1) of this section applies to:**

14 **(a) Coos County;**

15 **(b) Curry County;**

16 **(c) Douglas County;**

17 **(d) Josephine County;**

18 **(e) Klamath County;**

19 **(f) Lane County; and**

20 **(g) Linn County.**

21 [*(3) This section is repealed on January 2, 2016.*]

22 [*(4) This section applies to moneys described in subsections (1) and (2) of this section that are re-*
23 *ceived before, on or after September 27, 2007.*]

24 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, by section 1
25 of this 2012 Act, apply to moneys received by a county before, on or after the effective date
26 of this 2012 Act.

27 **SECTION 3.** Section 4, chapter 894, Oregon Laws 2007, as amended by section 1, chapter

1 556, Oregon Laws 2011, and section 1 of this 2012 Act, is repealed on January 2, 2016.

2 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding ORS 294.060, 294.468 (1)(c) and 368.705, a county that re-
3 ceives moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) and deposits those moneys into the county's road
4 fund may make an interfund loan of the moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) to any other
5 fund of that county for the purpose of patrolling of county roads by county law enforcement
6 officials.

7 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding ORS 294.468 (2)(c) and (3), an interfund loan by a county
8 that loans moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) from the county's road fund into any other
9 fund of that county to be used for the purpose of patrolling of county roads by county law
10 enforcement officials shall be budgeted and repaid into the county road fund within three
11 years following the end of the ensuing year or ensuing budget period.

12 **SECTION 6.** This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
13 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect
14 on its passage.
