

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4176

- 1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 13, delete “the governing body of the county”.
- 2 In line 14, delete “and other”.
- 3 On page 3, line 21, after “203.100.” delete the rest of the line and delete lines 22 through 45.
- 4 On page 4, delete line 1 and insert:
- 5 “(1)(a) A fiscal assistance board established pursuant to ORS 203.095 consists of:
- 6 “(A) Five members appointed by the Governor who have knowledge of and experience with
- 7 county services and fiscal management;
- 8 “(B) All members of the governing body of the county, who serve as ex officio members;
- 9 “(C) The sheriff for the county, who serves as an ex officio member, and who:
- 10 “(i) Is a voting member for matters concerning public safety services; and
- 11 “(ii) Is a nonvoting member for all other matters;
- 12 “(D) The Secretary of State, the State Treasurer and the Director of the Department of Revenue,
- 13 who serve as nonvoting ex officio members;
- 14 “(E) One nonvoting member appointed by the President of the Senate; and
- 15 “(F) One nonvoting member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 16 “(b) Prior to making appointments under this section, the Governor shall consult with the
- 17 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the purpose of receiving
- 18 their recommendations for appointments.
- 19 “(2) A fiscal assistance board shall perform the functions described in this section and ORS
- 20 203.095.
- 21 “(3) A majority of the members of the fiscal assistance board who are appointed by the Governor
- 22 and a majority of the county officials listed in subsection (1)(a)(B) and (C) of this section must be
- 23 present to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. A meeting of the board constitutes
- 24 a meeting of both the board and the county governing body and requires appropriate meeting notices
- 25 and adherence to public meeting laws under ORS 192.610 to 192.690.
- 26 “(4) Official action by the fiscal assistance board requires the approval of:
- 27 “(a) A majority of the members of the board who are appointed by the Governor; and
- 28 “(b) A majority of the county officials listed in subsection (1)(a)(B) and (C) of this section.”.
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
