

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5202

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 After line 20 of the printed bill, insert:

2 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
3 **\$1,838,489 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit**
4 **for the payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous**
5 **Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Depart-**
6 **ment of Transportation for the acquisition of land and the acquisition, planning, construct-**
7 **ing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of buildings and facilities for the**
8 **Department of Transportation field office in Bend.**

9 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
10 **expenditures established by section 1 (7)(a), chapter 615, Oregon Laws 2011, for a six-year**
11 **period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
12 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and**
13 **federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Veterans’ Affairs, for the acquisi-**
14 **tion of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and**
15 **equipping of buildings or facilities for the Lebanon Veterans’ Home, is increased by**
16 **\$10,126,096.**

17 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
18 **\$19,362,748 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit**
19 **for the expenditure of federal funds collected or received by the Department of Veterans’**
20 **Affairs for the acquisition of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, re-**
21 **pairing, furnishing and equipping of buildings and facilities for the Lebanon Veterans’ Home.**

22 **“SECTION 6. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
23 **\$42,700,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit**
24 **for payment of expenses under this section from Article XI-F(1) bond proceeds collected or**
25 **received by the Oregon University System for the Student Experience Center project at**
26 **Oregon State University.**

27 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$29,000,000 is**
28 **established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment**
29 **of expenses under this section from Article XI-F(1) bond proceeds collected or received by**
30 **the Oregon University System for a new student residence project at Oregon State Univer-**
31 **sity.**

32 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$9,177,500 is es-**
33 **tablished for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of**
34 **expenses under this section from Article XI-F(1) bond proceeds collected or received by the**
35 **Oregon University System for the Memorial Union east wing renovation project at Oregon**

1 State University.

2 “SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
3 \$1,000,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit
4 for payment of expenses under this section from Article XI-F(1) bond proceeds collected or
5 received by the Oregon University System for the Natural Sciences Laboratory Annex project
6 at Western Oregon University, previously authorized in section 9 (8)(b), chapter 615, Oregon
7 Laws 2011.

8 “SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this 2012 Act, the bond proceeds,
9 the expenditures from which are limited by sections 6 and 7 of this 2012 Act, are not available
10 for expenditure before the effective date of this 2012 Act. However, any action taken by the
11 State Board of Higher Education prior to the effective date of this 2012 Act or any contract
12 entered into by the board prior to the effective date of this 2012 Act necessary for the ac-
13 quisition, construction, improvement, repair, equipping and furnishing of buildings, struc-
14 tures, land and other projects or parts thereof, authorized by sections 6 and 7 of this 2012
15 Act, is hereby authorized.

16 “SECTION 9. Notwithstanding the expenditure limitations established under section 7 of
17 this 2012 Act and section 9, chapter 615, Oregon Laws 2011, the State Board of Higher Edu-
18 cation may increase the limit for expenditures from other revenues, including federal funds,
19 prescribed by section 9 (8)(b), chapter 615, Oregon Laws 2011, for the Natural Sciences Lab-
20 oratory Annex project at Western Oregon University, if the expenditure limitation for bonds
21 issued pursuant to Article XI-F(1) of the Oregon Constitution for the same project is reduced
22 by the board in the same amount.

23 “SECTION 10. For purposes of section 1, Article XI-F(1) of the Oregon Constitution, the
24 Legislative Assembly determines that the projects authorized to be financed pursuant to
25 sections 6 and 7 of this 2012 Act with bonds issued under Article XI-F(1) of the Oregon
26 Constitution will benefit higher education institutions or activities.

27 “SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following
28 amounts are established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit
29 for payment of expenses under this section from lottery bond proceeds collected or received
30 by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development pursuant to section
31 2, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2012 (Enrolled House Bill 5201), for community college dis-
32 tricts for capital construction, deferred maintenance, capital renewal, code compliance and
33 safety projects:
