

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1565

By COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE, HUMAN SERVICES AND RURAL HEALTH
POLICY

February 8

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “, 677.545,” and delete line 3 and insert “and 677.545;
2 and declaring an emergency.”.

3 In line 10, after “subsection” insert “, and except as permitted under ORS 677.515 (4)”.

4 On page 2, after line 2, insert:

5 “(4) A supervising physician or supervising physician organization that supervises a physician
6 assistant with dispensing authority shall comply with rules adopted by the State Board of Pharmacy
7 relating to registration, acquisition, storage, integrity, security, access, dispensing and disposal of
8 drugs, record keeping and consultation with pharmacists.”.

9 In line 3, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)”.

10 Delete lines 5 through 45 and delete pages 3 and 4.

11 On page 5, delete lines 1 through 31.

12 In line 32, delete “5” and insert “3”.

13 On page 7, line 39, delete “6” and insert “4”.

14 On page 8, line 32, delete “7” and insert “5”.

15 On page 9, delete lines 10 through 45 and delete page 10 and insert:

16 **“SECTION 6. (1) Section 2 of this 2012 Act and the amendments to ORS 677.510, 677.515
17 and 677.545 by sections 3 to 5 of this 2012 Act become operative on June 1, 2012.**

18 **“(2) The Oregon Medical Board and the State Board of Pharmacy may take any action
19 on or before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary
20 to enable the boards to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1)
21 of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the boards by section 2
22 of this 2012 Act and the amendments to ORS 677.510, 677.515 and 677.545 by sections 3 to 5
23 of this 2012 Act.**

24 **“SECTION 7. This 2012 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2012 Act takes effect
26 on its passage.”.**
