

Senate Concurrent Resolution 203

Sponsored by Senator HASS, Representative BARKER; Senator DEVLIN, Representatives KOMP, LINDSAY, READ
(Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Commemorates Jubilee Year of Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon and their 125 years of dedicated ministry and service.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Whereas the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon, which was founded in Sublimity in 1886, will
3 celebrate the closing of the Sisters' Jubilee Year on March 25, 2012; and

4 Whereas the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon built, in 1894, a Motherhouse in Beaverton for the
5 purpose of carrying out the ministries of service to those in need; and

6 Whereas the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon have been on a mission of education since 1903;
7 and

8 Whereas the educational ministries that the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon founded continue
9 today on the Sisters' 43-acre Beaverton campus, at Valley Catholic Early Learning School, Valley
10 Catholic Elementary School, Valley Catholic Middle School, Valley Catholic High School and Valley
11 Catholic Music School; and

12 Whereas the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon are on a mission of elder care, achieved, in part,
13 through the continuous operation of Maryville Nursing Home since 1963, for the purpose of main-
14 taining the health and promoting the dignity of those who have been made infirm by disability or
15 age; and

16 Whereas the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon are women of prayer, living in simplicity and
17 sisterly love; and

18 Whereas for over 125 years the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon have been turning faith into
19 action for the benefit of countless individuals and families throughout the Pacific Northwest and
20 beyond; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

22 That we, the members of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly, recognize, honor and celebrate
23 on behalf of all Oregonians the Jubilee Year of the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon and their 125
24 years of dedicated ministry and service to Oregon individuals, families and communities; and be it
25 further

26 Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be presented to Sister Charlene Herinckx, Superior
27 General of the Sisters of Saint Mary of Oregon.
