in ORS 294.060 (1) that are received by [*Douglas County*] a county listed in
subsection (2) of this section and deposited into [*its*] that county's road
fund may be expended for the patrolling of [*Douglas County*] that county's
roads by [*Douglas County*] that county's law enforcement officials.

9 "(2) [Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 and 368.705, moneys described in ORS 10 294.060 (1) that are received by Lane County and deposited into its road fund 11 may be expended for the patrolling of Lane County roads by Lane County law 12 enforcement officials.] Subsection (1) of this section applies to:

- 13 "(a) Curry County;
- 14 "(b) Douglas County;
- 15 "(c) Josephine County;
- 16 "(d) Klamath County;
- 17 "(e) Lane County; and
- 18 "(f) Linn County.
- 19 "[(3) This section is repealed on January 2, 2016.]

20 "[(4) This section applies to moneys described in subsections (1) and (2) of

21 this section that are received before, on or after September 27, 2007.]".

22 After line 27, insert:

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 294.060, 294.468 (1)(c) and 368.705,
a county that receives moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) and deposits those moneys into the county's road fund may make an interfund
loan to any other fund of that county for the purpose of patrolling of
county roads by county law enforcement officials.

6 "SECTION 5. Notwithstanding ORS 294.468 (2)(c) and (3), an inter-7 fund loan by a county that loans moneys described in ORS 294.060 (1) 8 from the county's road fund into any other fund of that county to be 9 used for the purpose of patrolling of county roads by county law 10 enforcement officials shall be budgeted and repaid into the county 11 road fund within two years following the end of the ensuing year or 12 ensuing budget period.".

In line 28, delete "4" and insert "6".
