

JOINT INTERIM SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT Committee Rules Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly

The Joint Interim Special Committee on Economic Development will operate in accordance with the Oregon Constitution, Senate and House Rules, Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure and applicable statutory provisions.

- 1. Committee rules may be amended by the affirmative vote of a majority of the appointed members of each house, but at least one day's notice shall be given in writing to each Committee member.
- 2. A quorum shall be comprised of a majority of the appointed members of each house. In the absence of a quorum, the Co-Chairs may assign fewer members to receive public testimony. Quorum for such hearings shall be one member from each house.
- 3. The officers of the Committee shall be one Co-Chair appointed by the President of the Senate and two Co-Chairs appointed by Co-Speakers of the House respectively.
- 4. The Co-Chairs shall call Committee meetings, set agendas and cause notice of the time and place of Committee meetings.
- 5. Subcommittees may be appointed by the Co-Chairs as necessary to complete the work of the Committee. However, only the full Committee is authorized to act on recommendations affecting any matter before the Committee. When referring any matter to a subcommittee for investigation, the Co-Chairs may specify the date by which the subcommittee report should be made to the Committee. A quorum of a subcommittee shall be a majority of the members appointed.
- 6. Hearing notices identifying an agenda of subjects to be considered by the Committee shall be posted in accordance with House and Senate Rules.
- 7. All meetings of the Committee shall be open to the public.
- 8. Upon the request of two members, a roll call vote shall be taken and recorded on any question.
- 9. The affirmative vote of a majority of the appointed members of each house shall be required to approve recommendations.
