- The Governor shall seek to employ people from all geographic regions of the state and from all communities having demonstrated ability to work in a cooperative and collaborative manner with people of diverse interests.
- The Governor shall also seek to appoint members from the following fields: business, small business, natural resources, community health, economics, sustainability, and conservation of natural resources.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 184.429

- Identify, evaluate, make recommendations and propose legislation, regulatory changes or policy modifications to agencies, the Governor, the Legislative Assembly, private entities or other bodies for the purpose of encouraging activities that best sustain, protect and enhance the quality of the environment, economy and community for the present and future benefit of Oregonians
- Develop and promote policies and programs that will assist in the meeting of sustainability goals specified in ORS 184.423
- Submit a biennial report to the Legislative Assembly by March 31 of each odd-numbered year on the board's activities and recommendations
- Apply for and accept appropriations, gifts, or grants of money or other property
- Develop and promote proposals that jointly and mutually enhance local economies, the environment and community health for the present and future benefit of Oregonians
- Consult with and seek comment from trade associations, organizations, businesses and other groups and individuals representing pertinent interests as part of developing recommendations
