# **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 3201

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows person holding interest in property to recover economic and property damages resulting from fire occurring due to certain statutory or rule violations or resulting from fire escaping from land used or capable of being used for growing forest tree species.

HB 3199

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits release of sky lantern, discharge of exploding target or discharge of tracer ammunition during fire season on or near forest protection district lands.

# **Work Session**

HB 2257

Allows Water Resources Department, upon request, to amend water right certificate to change names and addresses on certificate.

HB 2396

Adds large woody debris to definition of "material" for purposes of removal-fill provisions.

HB 2390

Repeals sunset on provisions that allow State Department of Fish and Wildlife to appoint person to act as agent for purpose of using one or more dogs to hunt or pursue black bear or cougar.
