Creates and modifies provisions related to regulation of outfitting and guiding services.
- HB 3201 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
CARRIED OVER FROM 3/12 AGENDA: Allows person holding interest in property to recover economic and property damages resulting from fire occurring due to certain statutory or rule violations or resulting from fire escaping from land used or capable of being used for growing forest tree species.
