SB 199 A

Changes approval process for lease transferring all or part of existing water right for use as in-stream water right.

SB 200 A

Allows record landowner holding certain water rights to apply for assignment of all or part of water right to owner of land to which water right pertains.

SB 25 A

Provides that State Marine Board has authority over certain charter boats carrying seven or more passengers.

SB 26

SB 31
