Public Hearing

HB 2061

First Public Hearing: Reduces amount of time that appraisal management company has to make payment to independent contractor appraiser for completion of appraisal or appraisal review assignment.

HB 2066

First Public Hearing: Allows certain personal property to be used as pledge for pledge loan from pawnbroker.

HB 2566

First Public Hearing: Permits board of directors of corporation to delegate to officer of corporation authority to designate recipients of rights, options, warrants and equity compensation awards for purchasing or receiving shares corporation.

HB 2567

First Public Hearing: Permits board of directors of corporation to authorize participation in shareholders' meeting by remote communication subject to guidelines and procedures of board.
