HB 2069

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to order payment of temporary disability compensation for up to 21 months for certain injured workers actively engaged in vocational assistance training.

HB 2634

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes Self-Insurer Security Fund for certain employers subject to workers' compensation laws.
