Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing

HB 2241

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to share information related to acquisitions of insurers under certain circumstances.

HB 2524

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Limits exemption from construction contractor licensing requirement for financial institutions, real estate personnel and suppliers of workers.

HB 2654

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits employer from compelling employee or applicant for employment to provide access to personal social media account or to add employer to social media contact list.

Work Session

HB 2070

Requires banking institution board of directors to hold regular meeting at least once every two months.
