Public Hearing

HB 2545

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Permits Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to debar from public works contract contractor or subcontractor that is limited liability company if member or manager of limited liability company fails to pay or post prevailing rate of wage, fails to pay subcontractor's employees when contractor pays employees on subcontractor's behalf or falsifies information on contractor's or subcontractor's certified statements.

HB 2646

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Applies provisions of prevailing wage law to agreement under terms of which private entity constructs, reconstructs, renovates or paints improvement on real property that Oregon University System or institution in Oregon University System owns or will use, occupy or ultimately own.

Public Hearing

HB 2675

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies definition of "public works." Classifies exemption from ad valorem property taxation as funds of public agency for purpose of requiring payment of prevailing rate of wage.

HB 2677

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Defines "funds of a public agency," for purposes of applying prevailing rate of wage to projects for public works, to include tax credits or tax abatements that contractor engaged in project for public work receives from state in connection with project.

HB 2061

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/25/2013 AGENDA: Reduces amount of time that appraisal management company has to make payment to independent contractor appraiser for completion of appraisal or appraisal review assignment.

HB 2069

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/25/2013 AGENDA: Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to order payment of temporary disability compensation for up to 21 months for certain injured workers actively engaged in vocational assistance training.

HB 2403

CARRIED OVER FROM 2/25/2013 AGENDA: Modifies manner in which scrap metal business may purchase metal for recycling purposes.
