HB 2619

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires person operating as landscape maintenance business to register with State Landscape Contractors Board.

HB 2907 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries to establish full-time equivalent position for investigator to investigate misclassification of employees as independent contractors.

HB 2908 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Interagency Compliance Network to conduct biennial review of usage of certain terms related to employment and to report findings to Legislative Assembly and appropriate interim legislative committee by September 15 of each even-numbered year.

Work Session

HB 2241

Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to share information related to acquisitions of insurers under certain circumstances.

HB 2688

Changes from \$250 to \$1,000 value of chattel for which person that forecloses lien on chattel by sale must file statement of account with recording officer of county in which sale takes place.

HB 2909

Renames Center for Research on Occupational and Environmental Toxicology to Oregon Institute of Occupational Health Sciences.
