HB 2113 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies fees for certain farm labor contractor licenses.

HB 2706
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Permits owner of self-service storage facility to charge late fee for failure to pay or late payment of rent due.

HB 2845
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits owner of self-service storage facility from selling or offering to sell insurance unless owner applies for and receives limited license from Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services.

HB 2900 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes Task Force on Unlawful Business-to-Business Trade Practices for purpose of investigating extent to which Oregon unlawful trade practices laws can and should be amended to apply to transactions between businesses.

Work Session

HB 2567
Permits board of directors of corporation to authorize participation in shareholders' meeting by remote communication subject to guidelines and procedures of board.

HB 2646
Applies provisions of prevailing wage law to agreement under terms of which private entity constructs, reconstructs, renovates or paints improvement on real property that Oregon University System or institution in Oregon University System owns or will use, occupy or ultimately own.

HB 2545

Permits Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to debar from public works contract contractor or subcontractor that is limited liability company if member or manager of limited liability company fails to pay or pay prevailing rate of wage, fails to pay subcontractor's employees when contractor pays employees on subcontractor's behalf or falsifies information on contractor's or subcontractor's certified statements.
