HB 2692

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs school districts to consider competence of teachers when determining which teachers will be retained when school district reduces staff in certain circumstances.

HB 2669

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Extends certain employee protections to persons performing work for educational purposes.

HB 2066

Allows certain personal property to be used as pledge for pledge loan from pawnbroker.

HB 2418

Modifies definition of "supervisory employee" for purposes of public employee collective bargaining law.

HB 2449

Makes strikes or recognition of picket line of labor organization by assistant attorneys general unlawful.

HB 2478 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for payments to employee and dependent scholarship programs.
