## **Public Hearing**

#### HB 2529

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: For purposes of unemployment insurance benefits, includes in definition of "employment" service performed by leaseholder in operation of passenger motor vehicle operated as taxicab or operated for nonemergency medical transportation.

#### HB 3147

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: For purposes of exclusion of service performed in operation of certain vehicles from definition of "employment" under unemployment compensation law, removes requirement that service be performer for entity operated by board of owner-operators elected by members of entity.

#### HB 2976 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Regulates entity that procures employment for others as employment agency when entity's services are paid for by anyone other than job applicant.

#### HB 2977 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires construction labor contractors to be licensed by Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries.

## HB 3142

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies definitions of "employ," "employee," "employer" and "wages" for purposes of statutes relating to hours, wages, wage claims, employment conditions, employment agencies, farm labor contractors and construction contractors.

Modifies fees for certain farm labor contractor licenses.

Establishes Task Force on Unlawful Business-to-Business Trade Practices for purpose of investigating extent to which Oregon unlawful trade practices laws can and should be amended to apply to transactions between businesses

HB 2845

Prohibits owner of self-service storage facility from selling or offering to sell insurance unless owner applies for and receives limited license from Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services.
