HB 2296

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Permits creation of, or conversion of other business entity into, benefit company that has purpose of providing general public benefit and possible specific public benefit in addition to other purposes.

HB 2469 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Extends sunset for tax credit for pension income.

HB 2669

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Extends certain employee protections to persons performing work for educational purposes.

HB 3243 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows certain deceased members of Public Employees Retirement System to be considered vested for all purposes under pension program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan.

HB 3343

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies authority of Port of Portland to establish contract standards.

#### Work Session

HB 2111

Revises standard for determination of whether individual is substantially limited in major life activity.

HB 2112

Authorizes imposition of civil penalty by Bureau of Labor and Industries for certain actions relating to deductions from compensation paid to employees.

HB 2915

Eliminates requirement for religious corporation to hold annual meeting if sole member of religious corporation is corporation sole or individual that constitutes corporation sole, provided that religious corporation is incorporated under state laws and is of same church or religious denomination as corporation sole.

HB 2449

CARRIED OVER FROM 3/15/2013 AGENDA: Makes strikes or recognition of picket line of labor organization by assistant attorneys general unlawful.

HB 2646

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/15/2013 AGENDA: Applies provisions of prevailing wage law to agreement under terms of which private entity constructs, reconstructs, renovates or paints improvement on real property that Oregon University System or institution in Oregon University System owns or will use, occupy or ultimately own.
