HB 3352

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Eliminates requirement that any person employed in factory or manufacturing establishment who works more than 10 hours in any one day be paid at rate of time and one-half regular rate for each hour worked over 10 hours.

HB 3361

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Defines "comparable" for purposes of arbitration between certain employees and Department of Corrections.

HB 3436

Creates Oregon Retirement Savings Investment Board.

HB 2654

Prohibits employer from compelling employee or applicant for employment to provide access to personal social media account or to add employer to social media contact list.
