#### Public Hearing

HB 2672

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes certain workplace protections for domestic workers.

HB 3026

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Includes siblings as family members for purposes of family leave.

HB 3095

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits public body from deeming franchisee employee of franchisor unless public body determines, with support of substantial evidence, that franchisor exercises more control over franchisee than is customary among franchisor and franchisee relationships in relevant market and than is necessary to preserve goodwill associated with trademark that franchisor licensed to franchisee.

HB 3347

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits motor vehicle manufacturer, distributor or importer from coercing or requiring dealer to construct new dealer facility or materially alter or remodel existing dealer facility within 10 years after date on which dealer previously constructed, materially altered or remodeled existing dealer facility if existing dealer facility complies with manufacturer's, distributor's or importer's approved brand image standards or plans that existed at time dealer facility was constructed.

HB 2903

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires certain employers to post in premises where employees are employed summary of statutes and rules related to employment rights of victims of domestic violence, harassment, sexual assault or stalking.
