#### Public Hearing

HB 2535

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires workers' compensation premium rates for clients of temporary service provider to be based on client's experience rating.

HB 3342

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits public employer from assisting, promoting or deterring union organizing and from using public property to hold meeting with employee or supervisor if purpose of meeting is to assist, promote or deter union organizing.

HB 3347

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits motor vehicle manufacturer, distributor or importer from coercing or requiring dealer to construct new dealer facility or materially alter or remodel existing dealer facility within 10 years after date on which dealer previously constructed, materially altered or remodeled existing dealer facility if existing dealer facility complies with manufacturer's, distributor's or importer's approved brand image standards or plans that existed at time dealer facility was constructed.

#### Work Session

HB 2698

Eliminates sunset on provisions for training, qualifying and certifying specialized building inspectors.

HB 2706

Permits owner of self-service storage facility to charge late fee for failure to pay or late payment of rent due.

HB 2296

Permits creation of, or conversion of other business entity into, benefit company that has purpose of providing general public benefit and possible specific public benefit in addition to other purposes.

- HB 2643 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Office of Secretary of State to conduct study regarding fees imposed on small businesses by local and state agencies and to implement program to assist small businesses in obtaining waivers or deferrals of fees.
- HB 3243 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Allows certain deceased members of Public Employees Retirement System to be considered vested for all purposes under pension program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan.
- HB 3343  
Modifies authority of Port of Portland to establish contract standards.
