HB 2706

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/1 AGENDA: Permits owner of self-service storage facility to charge late fee for failure to pay or late payment of rent due.

HB 2683

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/1 AGENDA: Authorizes employer to pay wages due employee through direct deposit into employee's account or by other means of electronic transfer.

HB 2448

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/1 AGENDA: Requires issue subject to collective bargaining during term of collective bargaining agreement that is not resolved through negotiation or mediation to be resolved through binding arbitration.

HB 2903

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/1 AGENDA: Requires certain employers to post in premises where employees are employed summary of statutes and rules related to employment rights of victims of domestic violence, harassment, sexual assault or stalking.

HB 3361

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/1 AGENDA: Defines "comparable" for purposes of arbitration between certain employees and Department of Corrections.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires covered employer to implement paid sick leave for eligible employees.

HB 2669

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Extends certain employee protections to persons performing work for educational purposes.

HB 3076 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Directs Bureau of Labor and Industries to study methods of resolving postemployment disputes and report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly on or before Septembe 1, 2014.
