HB 2654

Prohibits employer from compelling employee or applicant for employment to provide access to personal social media account or to add employer to social media contact list.

HB 2469 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for pension income.

HB 2692

Directs school districts to consider competence of teachers when determining which teachers will be retained when school district reduces staff in certain circumstances.

HB 2672

Establishes certain workplace protections for domestic workers.

HB 2214

NOTE: NO AMENDMENTS ARE UNDER CONSIDERATION: Exempts employees of attorneys from licensure and other requirements relating to tax return preparation.

HB 2950

Allows eligible employees to take family leave to deal with death of family member.

FRIST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires State of Oregon to grant paid leave to eligible employees who are victims of domestic violence, harassment, sexual assault or stalking.

HB 3459 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes Office of Small Business Assistance in Office of Secretary of State for purpose of facilitating interactions between small businesses and state agencies with regulatory authority over small businesses.

HB 3005
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes person with legal estate in real property to evict person in possession of real property under lease or rental agreement for conduct that causes place to be nuisance.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Urges United States Department of State and United States Department of Justice to emphasize protecting intellectual property rights and to provide training and guidance to diplomatic and law enforcement personnel stationed overseas to enable personnel to serve as effective advocates for and enforcers of intellectual property rights.
