Prohibits employer from compelling employee or applicant for employment to provide access to personal social meaccount or to add employer to social media contact list.

HB 2469 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for pension income.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes person with legal estate in real property to evict person in possession of real property under lease or rental agreement for conduct that causes place to be nuisance.
