SB 142

Permits authorized agent of incorporator, director, officer or receiver, trustee or fiduciary of business entity to execu filings for office of Secretary of State.

SB 205

Eliminates requirement that Construction Contractors Board rules require certain contract terms as mandatory contractors.

SB 207 A

Requires that construction contractor license application filed by limited partnership include name and address of certain limited partnership members.

### **Work Session**

SB 264

Modifies definition of "managerial employee" to include certain employees of Oregon University System.

SB 268

Allows amounts contributed for employee by State Board of Higher Education or Oregon Health and Science University Board of Directors for supplemental retirement benefits to be transferred to Public Employees Retiremer Fund to offset liabilities for employer contributions of board if employee separates from service of board before certain period elapses.

SB 269

Modifies provisions relating to Optional Retirement Plan for administrative and academic employees of Oregon University System.
