- SB 135  
Abolishes Wage and Hour Commission.
- SB 677  
Creates exception to requirement that wages due to seasonal farmworker must be paid immediately after termination of employment.
- SB 744  
Requires council on civil rights appointed by Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study wage equality in Oregon and report findings to Legislative Assembly.

#### Work Session

- SB 207 A  
Requires that construction contractor license application filed by limited partnership include name and address of certain limited partnership members.
- SB 264  
Modifies definition of "managerial employee" to include certain employees of Oregon University System.
- SJM 5  
Urges Acting Secretary of Commerce and United States Trade Representative to investigate extent of subsidies Chi grants to Chinese paper manufacturers and whether subsidies violate World Trade Organization rules, and to evaluate impact Chinese subsidies have on United States paper manufacturers.
