Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 344 A

Prohibits certain educational institutions from requiring or compelling student or prospective student to provide institution with access to personal social media account through user name and password, password or other means authentication.

SB 625 A

Provides Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services or local building official with authority to determine whether structure plans and specifications, or structure as constructed, meets fire and life safety standards and other state building code standards.

SB 795 A

Permits brewery-public house licensee to store, transport and sell malt beverages at one location other than where manufacturing occurs.

SB 678 A

Extends exclusive remedy protections of workers' compensation statutes to partners, limited liability company members, general partners, limited liability partners and limited partners.
