Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2140 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes discrete investment of funds of political subdivisions in any commingled investment pool established by State Treasurer for investment of funds of state agencies or local governments.
- HB 2141
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Repeals outdated statute relating to county fairgrounds.
- HB 2142
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Repeals certain outdated statutes relating to county treasurers.
- HB 2143
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Eliminates requirement that Department of Corrections inspect local detention facilities for compliance with specified provisions of state law.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2211
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Abolishes Information Resources Management Council and Stakeholders Advisory Committee in Oregon Department of Administrative Services.
- HB 2609
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Deletes requirement that county audit include audit of circuit court.
