HB 2210

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Establishes category of professional service in state service.

HB 2239

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires certain entities previously exempt from requirement to have license in order to engage in business of making mortgage loans to now obtain license from Department of Consumer and Business Services.

Work Session

HB 2143

Eliminates requirement that Department of Corrections inspect local detention facilities for compliance with specific provisions of state law.

HB 2140 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes discrete investment of funds of political subdivisions in any commingled investment pool established by State Treasurer for investment of funds of state agencies or local governments.

HB 2207

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires payment of state payroll to be made through direct electronic deposit.

HB 2429

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires that public bodies develop and implement policies for securely removing personal information from digital data storage devices and other electronic data storage devices before selling, donating, recycling or otherwise disposing of device.

HB 2531

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Expands definition of "appraisal management company" to include companies orderin appraisals for purposes not related to mortgage loans or mortgage securities.
