Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing

HB 2528

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Removes cap on amount in real estate loan agreement that is subject to requirement to pay interest to borrower on funds that lender collects for lender's security protection provision.

HB 2568

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides that in amended notice of sale following release from stay on foreclosure proceedings, trustee must describe only defaults that existed on date stay was terminated if portion of defaults specified in original notice of sale was cured during stay or if additional defaults have occurred during stay.

HB 2569

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows law practices to serve as trustees of trust deeds.

HB 2662

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits owner of foreclosed residential real property from neglecting foreclosed residential real property during period of vacancy.

HB 2822

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Disallows publication of notice of sale of real property by Internet posting without additional publication in newspaper of general circulation.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2059

Requires consignee to refrain from certain practices and to hold moneys consignee receives from sale of personal property in trust account if consignee does not pay moneys immediately to person that offered, gave or entrusted personal property to consignee.

HB 2060

Allows Attorney General to issue order disqualifying charitable organization from receiving contributions that are deductible for purpose of Oregon income tax and corporate excise tax if Attorney General finds that charitable organization has failed to expend at least 30 percent of total annual functional expenses on program services when those expenses are averaged over most recent three fiscal years.
