HB 2059

CARRIED OVER FROM 02/21/2013 AGENDA: Requires consignee to refrain from certain practices and to hold moneys consignee receives from sale of personal property in trust account if consignee does not pay moneys immediately to person that offered, gave or entrusted personal property to consignee.

HB 2060

CARRIED OVER FROM 02/21/2013 AGENDA: Allows Attorney General to issue order disqualifying charitable organization from receiving contributions that are deductible for purpose of Oregon income tax and corporate excise tax if Attorney General finds that charitable organization has failed to expend at least 30 percent of total annual functional expenses on program services when those expenses are averaged over most recent three fiscal years.

HB 2346

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides that enrolled customer consents to receive notice of modification or termination of portable electronics insurance policy by electronic means if, after insurer, insurer's agent or vendor of sold portable electronics notifies enrolled customer that providing electronic mail address to insurer, insurer's agent or vendor is consent to receive notice by electronic means, enrolled customer provides electronic mail address.

HB 2370 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires that additional information be posted on Oregon transparency website.

HB 2429

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires that public bodies develop and implement policies for securely removing personal information from digital data storage devices and other electronic data storage devices before selling, donating, recycling or otherwise disposing of device.

HB 2829

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Allows counties to choose methods of publishing schedule of expenditures and notice of publication of schedule of expenditures.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Increases amount of money and goods that person may find without giving notice to county clerk.
