HB 2212

Raises amount used to classify public procurement as small procurement under Public Contracting Code from maximum of \$5,000 to maximum of \$10,000.

HB 2829

Allows counties to choose methods of publishing schedule of expenditures and notice of publication of schedule of expenditures.

HB 2830

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires contractor of new residential structure or zero-lot-line dwelling to provide property owner or original purchaser warranty for building envelope and penetration components.

HB 2978

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Sets out uniform provisions for certain aspects of state building code administration and enforcement.

HB 3144 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Revises language regarding assumption of administration and enforcement of manufactured dwelling services, building inspection program or partial building inspection program after municipal ceases administration and enforcement.

HB 3145 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Makes legislative findings regarding merits of state agency administration and enforcement of state building code for capital construction projects receiving state-supplied funding.

HB 3166

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes registered environmental health technicians to provide technical support and assistance to environmental health specialists, environmental health specialist trainees, waste water specialists and waste water specialist trainees.

HB 3167 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Provides that certain local units of government may contract with private entities to assist local units of government in carrying out certain duties related to sewage.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires seller of real property to obtain septic system evaluation report and provide copies to Department of Environmental Quality and to each buyer that makes written offer to purchase.
